



## 7-point grading scale

ECTS grades (ap- plicable until 31 August 2007)	7-point grading scale (applicable as of 1 September 2007)	Performance	Description
A	12	Excellent	The grade 12 shall be awarded for an excellent performance displaying a high level of command of all aspects of the relevant material, with no or only a few minor weaknesses.
B	10	Very good	The grade 10 shall be awarded for a very good performance displaying a high level of command of most aspects of the relevant material, with only minor weaknesses.
C	7	Good	The grade 7 shall be awarded for a good performance displaying good command of the relevant material, but also some weaknesses.
D	4	Fair	The grade 4 shall be awarded for a fair performance displaying some command of the relevant material, but also some major weaknesses.
E	02	Adequate	The grade 02 shall be awarded for a performance meeting only the minimum requirements for acceptance.
Fx	00	Inadequate	The grade 00 shall be awarded for a performance, which does not meet the minimum requirements for acceptance.
F	3	Unacceptable	The grade -3 shall be awarded for a performance, which is unacceptable in all respects.

The grades “00” and “-3” are not passing grades.

Translation of the 7-point grading scale into English

12: For an excellent performance displaying a high level of command of all aspects of the

relevant material, with no or only a few minor weaknesses.

10: For a very good performance displaying a high level of command of most aspects of the relevant material, with only minor weaknesses.

7: For a good performance displaying good command of the relevant material, but also some weaknesses.

4: For a fair performance displaying some command of the relevant material, but also some major weaknesses.

02: For a performance meeting only the minimum requirement for acceptance.

00: For a performance, which does not meet the minimum requirements for acceptance.

-3: For a performance, which is unacceptable in all respects.
